-NWAC ISET Funding: Deadline not specified, Open year round to students with at least one year of study left in their program, for indigenous women (Indigenous Skills and Employment Training (ISET) - NWAC)

-Moss Bag Bursary: Deadline not specified, for indigenous mothers in post secondary, 2,000\$ (<u>The Moss Bag Project</u>)

-ATCO Indigenous Education Bursary: Next deadline August 15th, up to \$1,800 (Indigenous Education Programs (atco.com))

-NiB Trust Fund: Deadline is June 9th, 2023, open to all indigenous students in a post secondary program. (<u>NIBTrust</u>)

-ONECA: 2 programs, Four Directions Scholarship for graduating students for 1,000\$, and PS Student Award, 2023 application deadline not yet posted (Four Directions Scholarship - ONECA - ONECA - The Ontario Native Education Counselling Association)
